***ATTENTION**: Out-of-State Applicants

If your training consisted of the <u>same or more hours</u> than the Virginia requirement, you must submit documentation of your training (see <u>Training & Experience Verification Form</u>).

If your hours were <u>less than</u> Virginia's requirement, then you must submit proof of 6 months' work experience along with your training documentation (*see* <u>Training & Experience Verification Form</u>).
